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Workshop Title: MASK DECORATING

Length: 90 minute to ½ day workshop.

Location: On Site **OR** On the Road (see below)

About: Students learn painting and appliqué techniques to decorate a pre-formed, full- face or half- face mask. Students are able to take away their finished mask to wear or hang as art. This workshop is for schools or organizations that are looking for an enriching and low-pressure opportunity for their students/participants.

Recommended Age Range: minimum 8 to 10 years, up to adult / general public

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the On the Road workshop is booked by school. A teacher must be
 present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- 1. One blank plastic pre-formed mask for each participant to decorate and keep,
- 2. Paints/paint brushes/glue guns and appliqué supplies for decorating,
- 3. Kraft paper/plastic coverings to protect tables and desks.

On the Road Workshop Room Set Up and Technical Requirements:

- classroom or art room,
- students can work at desks pushed together in groupings of 4 to 6 or at long tables that can accommodate 6 to 8 participants,
- one separate table for Instructor's supplies and demonstration area,
- access to two or more electrical outlets,
- access to sinks/water for brush clean up and hand washing station,
- workshop participants should wear cover-ups to protect their clothing. (These will not be supplied by the instructor.)

Workshop Title: MASK MAKING

Length: ½ or full day to accomplish all steps and drying times.

Location: On site **OR** On the Road (see below)

About: Students learn to sculpt, construct and decorate theatrical masks using a variety of materials. They explore different mask making techniques to create wire, buckram, foam and additive sculpture masks, develop skills to fit masks properly to actors, learn painting techniques to enhance the sculpted mask. Students take home their completed masks.

Recommended Age Range: 14 years and up /adult / general public

Recommended Number of Participants:

- A full class size may be accommodated if On the Road workshop is booked by a school; a teacher must be
 present at all time during this workshop.
- 15 participants or more can be accommodated at OTW studio. Number of participants for **off-site** workshop will be discussed at time of booking.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- 1. Sculpting material/all other materials required for mask creation,
- 2. If workshop is delivered at OTW studio, students will create a plastic positive with OTW vacuum-form machine. *Note: This option is NOT available "On the Road"*
- 3. Paints/paint brushes/glue guns and appliqué supplies for decorating,
- 4. Kraft paper/plastic coverings to protect tables/desks.

On the Road Workshop Room Set Up and Technical Requirements:

- classroom or art room,
- students can work at desks pushed together in groupings of 4 to 6 or at long tables that can accommodate 6 to 8 participants,

Workshop Title: MASK MAKING SPECIFIC TO A SHOW

Length: Full day

Location: On Site OR On the Road (see below)

About: Prior to this workshop being delivered, the instructor must be in contact with the organization/director/production designer/teacher or individual requesting the workshop to discuss the particular requirements of this 'specific to production workshop'. The workshop details and expectations must be decided on and agreed on prior to the actual workshop taking place to ensure the workshop expectations are known and met. There will be a 'prep fee' for this workshop for the instructor's time and expertise in preparing for the workshop.

Recommended Age Range: adult / secondary school

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the On the Road workshop is booked by school. A teacher must be
 present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 or more participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- 1. OTW will supply some materials and offer ideas for participants to contribute materials. Specifics are identified during preparatory discussions,
- 2. Paints/paint brushes/glue guns/masking tape and appliqué supplies,
- 3. Kraft paper/plastic coverings to protect tables and desks,
- 4. If workshop is delivered **on site**, access to the vacuum form machine is available.

On the Road Workshop Room Set Up and Technical Requirements:

- classroom or art room,
- students can work at desks pushed together in groupings of 4 to 6 or at long tables that can accommodate 6 to 8 participants,
- one separate table for Instructor's supplies and demonstration area,

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Workshop Title: PROP MAKING ON A BUDGET

Length: From 90 minutes to ½ day

Location: On site OR On the Road (see below)

About: A fun workshop on how to make theatrical props on a limited budget. Students start with a drawing or image and progress through to a completed object using different materials, techniques and methodology that can be made in an efficient and cost-effective manner.

Recommended Age Range: 14 years to adult

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the **On the Road** workshop is booked by school. A teacher **must** be present at all times during school workshops.
- 12 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

Off the Wall Instructor will supply all materials required for this workshop. A materials fee may be assessed on a per-participant basis.

On the Road Workshop Room Set Up and Technical Requirements:

- 1. classroom or art room,
- students can work at desks pushed together in groupings of 4 to 6 or at long tables that can accommodate 6 to 8 participants, one separate table for Instructor's supplies and demonstration area,
- 3. access to two or more electrical outlets,

Workshop Title: FOAM WEAPONS

Length: 90 minute, ½ day, full day

Location: On site **OR** On the Road (see below)

About: Safety issues are discussed with students to ensure awareness and all protocols surrounding prop weapons are understood. Working with hard and soft foam material, the students learn various techniques to create foam weapons for the stage. Painting techniques, carving, sculpting, taping and other foam prop making techniques are explored.

Recommended Age Range: 14 years – adult / general public

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the On the Road workshop is booked by school. A teacher must
 be present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 participants or more can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

Off the Wall Instructor will supply all materials required for this workshop. A materials fee may be required of each participant.

Workshop Title: PUPPET MAKING - UPCYCLE

Length: 1 to 2 hours.

Location: On site **OR** On the Road (see below)

About: Unleash your imagination and gain a new perspective on how to follow the 3 R's: *Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.* This workshop explores and teaches students how to make puppets/props using recycled materials and objects. Students are taken through the process of creating a small (or large) prop to keep.

Recommended Age Range: 8 to 10 years, adult / general public

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the **On the Road** workshop is booked by school. A teacher **must** be present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- 1. OTW will supply some materials and offer ideas for participants; participants will be asked to contribute materials specified at time of booking.
- 2. Paints/paint brushes/glue guns/masking tape and appliqué supplies,

Workshop Title: FAUX FOOD

Length: 90 minute, ½ day, full day

Location: On site **OR** On the Road (see below)

About: Students create a plethora of different prop foods using a variety of craft materials. The instructor brings many examples and goes through different ways to create faux food for theatre, film/TV or display. Depending on the length of course you choose, students create a range of sample foods such as, chocolates, cupcakes, pies, chicken legs and more.

Recommended Age Range: 8 to 10 years, adult / general public

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the **On the Road** workshop is booked by school. A teacher **must** be present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- Off the Wall Instructor will supply all materials required for this workshop.
- A materials fee may be required of each participant.

Workshop Title: SCULPTURE

Length: 70 minutes or Full Day

Location: On Site OR On the Road (see below)

About: Release your inner Rodin!

Students learn to create a small-scale sculpture with plasticine. The workshop progresses from the initial concept to completion using a variety of materials. Sculpting is one aspect of prop making and is also used in the creation of a 'stand alone' art piece.

Recommended Age Range: adult / teen

This workshop can be delivered on site at the Off the Wall studio or delivered at a Secondary School location.

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to students.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the On the Road workshop is booked by school. A teacher must
 be present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

Workshop Title: SCENIC ART FAUX FINISHES

Length: ½ Day to Full Day

Location: On site OR On the Road (see below)

About: Instruction of this class is supported with a power-point presentation. This instructor-led workshop offers a table top demonstration on sample boards by a master scenic painter. A half day workshop offers demonstration and limited hands-on creation. Full Day workshop allows for bigger scale creation due to materials and drying times. A rare opportunity to work with a master scenic painter!

Recommended Age Range: adult/teenage. This workshop can be delivered on site at the Off the Wall studio or delivered at a Secondary School location.

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to teens.
- A full class size can be accommodated if the On the Road workshop is booked by a school. A teacher
 must be present at all times during school workshops.

Length: ½ day to full day

About: This workshop offers a basic introduction to scenic art painting. Acrylic paints will be used and an easel is required for each student's use.

Recommended Age Range: elementary grade 7-8 / secondary school

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is the ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to students.
- 15 participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall studio.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- Off the Wall Instructor will supply all materials required for this workshop.
- A materials fee may be assessed on a per-participant basis.
- Art easels are NOT supplied by Off the Wall.

On the Road Workshop Room Set Up and Technical Requirements:

- 1. classroom or art room,
- 2. one separate table for Instructor's supplies and demonstration area,
- 3. access to two or more electrical outlets,
- 4. access to sinks/water for brush clean up and hand washing station,
- 5. each student must have access to an easel. This can be discussed at time of booking.

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Workshop Title: THEATRICAL MAKEUP - BASIC STAGE MAKEUP

Length: ½ day, full day

Location: On Site OR On the Road (see below)

About: This workshop covers the basics of stage makeup with a focus on special effects such as aging, and teaches how to do a basic foundation, eyes, lips, cheeks required for stage lighting to look natural on stage.

Recommended Age Range: ages 14 and up /secondary school / adults

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is an ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop. An organizer **must** be present at all times during the delivery of the workshops to children/teens,
- A full class size can be accommodated if the **On the Road** workshop is booked by school. A teacher **must** be present at all times during school workshops.
- 15 or more participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio for this workshop.

Off the Wall will provide the following Materials and Supplies:

- 1. Off the Wall makeup instructors bring the tools of their trade with them, and offer suggestions to participants for creating an essential makeup kit.

Take the stress away and gain the confidence needed to put your 'best face forward' at the podium or photo shoot! Participants learn what they need in their makeup bag to accomplish a polished and professional look.

Recommended Age Range: adult

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 6 to 12 participants is an ideal number for this **On the Road** workshop.
- 15 or more participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio for this workshop

- 1. Off the Wall makeup instructors bring the tools of their trade with them, and offer suggestions to participants for creating an essential makeup kit.

About: Attention Dance moms and dads! This is a not-to-be-missed family workshop that teaches parents and dancers how to confidently apply makeup appropriate for competition, performances and recitals. Learn what you need in that makeup kit and how to use it.

Recommended Age Range: adult / secondary school / elementary

Recommended Number of Participants:

- 16 or more participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio for this workshop.
- one parent MUST be present with their child/children for the duration of the workshop. **This is a parent** participatory workshop.

Length: ½ day, full day Location: On site only

About: This workshop is delivered on site at OTW Studio or designated workshop location due to workshop requirements. Learn to dress a wig for the stage. Participants will learn how to dress and maintain the wig throughout the demands of a theatrical run. This workshop is ideal for small theatre companies and community theatre groups who sometimes have large casts and small budgets and running crews.

Length: ½ day/full Day **Location:** On site

About: Students will learn to adapt a store-bought wig for theatrical use. This workshop is a must for

community theatre/secondary school productions with limited budgets and big dreams!

Recommended Number of Participants:

• 15 or more participants can be accommodated **on site** at the Off the Wall Studio for this workshop.

Workshop Title: COSTUME DESIGN AND BUILD

Length: Double Weekend Intensive

Location: On Site OR On the Road (see below) OR Virtual

About: Participants learn how to interpret a two-dimensional design and render it into a three-dimensional costume pattern in this double-weekend workshop. A Stratford Festival Cutter teaches the skills of interpreting sketches, drafting patterns, mocking up blocks and cutting a costume. This course is ideal for those working in costume or wardrobe departments, and those who build costumes for community theatre. The Instructor takes participants on a comprehensive journey from the design sketch to the actual build.

This 'How To' includes:

- What is cutting? Examine different body types; learn which measurements are taken and why. Practice taking
 proper measurements; discuss the way patterns work and discover how they are customized for specific
 actors; and explore how to interpret a variety of design sketches.
- Finish up with measurements and begin block development all day; talk about truing up your blocks, establishing size and ease; begin to establish style lines and period features within your basic block; begin mocking up the loose-fitting bodice in muslin, cutting out mockups.
- Sew mock ups and begin fitting them, talk about fittings and the importance of them, what to look for in fittings (drag lines, placement of seams and darts).
- Complete basic block fittings, as well as look at how the basic block turns into a period bodice, corset, blouse.
- Interpret a sketch into the blocks and look at different ways to manipulate the block; draft new patterns from the blocks; if time allows begin cutting out mock up for costume bodice.
- Draft and mock up costume bodice; conduct fittings if time allows.
